Rialtos is inspired by the warmth and awkwardness of early 20th century grotesks. Typefaces of this era, such as Venus and its contemporaries have an undeniable charm. However, the admiration of a typeface can be as much about the application as it is about the face itself. The character traits of these early grotesks are undeniably inspiring, but their associations with the work of Piet Zwart to that of Blue Note Records are equally important. Rialtos looks to this broader visual language to bring a contemporary relevance. Though it does reflect certain 'ear-marked' characteristics, Rialtos is more indebted to how Venus and the likes were applied versus their actual design.

The development of the West Side, Beverly Hills and Hollywood, beginning in the 1910s, siphoned away much of West Adams' upper-class white population; upperclass blacks began to move in around this time, although the district was off limits to all but the very wealthiest African-Americans. *One symbol of the area's emergence as a center of black wealth at this time is the landmark 1949 headquarters building of the Golden State Mutual Life Insurance Company,* a late-period Moderne structure at Adams and Western designed by renowned black architect Paul Williams. According to the "Mapping L.A." project of the Los Angeles Times, West Adams is flanked by Mid-City to the north-across the Santa Monica Freeway-Jefferson Park to the east, Baldwin Hills/Crenshaw to the south and Palms to the west. *The neighborhood's* street boundaries are the Santa Monica Freeway on the north, Crenshaw Boulevard on the east, Exposition and Jefferson Boulevards on the south and the Culver City line on the west (Ballona Creek and Fairfax Avenue). Project leader Doug Smith reported that, in response by the public to advance posting of the proposed maps, "Among the bitter rifts we encountered were the competing claims to the name West Adams." Historical purists would reserve the designation West Adams for the once-upper-crust district of Victorian mansions now falling in the shadow of
